**ORDER OF JUSTICE STRK
MADE ON 12 JULY 2021**

AFTER HEARING P Edgar on behalf of the Plaintiffs, P A Walker on behalf of Kipoi Holdings (the second interested party), and J G Abberton on behalf of Yingkou Yangzhou Trade Co Ltd (the first interested party) and Jinji Resources Finance Pty Ltd (the third interested party), IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Stay application

1. The plaintiffs, the first interested party and the third interested party file any responsive affidavits upon which they intend to rely by 4pm on Tuesday, 20 July 2021.
2. The second interested party file and serve any reply affidavits and its outline of submissions by 4pm on Monday, 26 July 2021.
3. The plaintiffs, the first interested party and the third interested party file and serve their outline of submissions by 4pm on Thursday, 29 July 2021.
4. The matter be listed for a special appointment on Tuesday, 3 August 2021, commencing at 10am.

Variation to programming orders

5. The Orders of the Court made 28 May 2021 (as amended by the Orders of the Court made 1 July 2021) (together, the Amended May Orders) be varied by changing:
 - (a) in Order 8, 22 July 2021 to 29 July 2021;
 - (b) in Order 9, 7 July 2021 to 12pm on 30 July 2021;

- (c) in Order 13, 26 July 2021 to 2 August 2021;
 - (d) in Order 14, 2 August 2021 to 6 August 2021.
6. The plaintiffs shall file and serve any submissions in reply limited to the joint expert report prepared by the parties' respective experts (as contemplated by Order 14 of the Amended May Orders) by 12pm on 16 August 2021.
 7. Kipoi Holdings Mauritius Limited, Yingkou Yanhgzhou Trade Co Ltd and Jinji Resources Finance Pty Ltd be given leave to be heard in the proceeding as interested parties.
 8. The third interested party will otherwise observe the programming directions made in the proceeding as they apply to the first interested party, to the extent to which the third interested party proposes to participate in the proceeding.

Costs

9. Costs be reserved.
