COURT ORDERS UNDER SECTIONS 255(4) AND 257(2) OF THE COMPANIES ACT 1993, AND FOR DIRECTIONS AS TO FILING AND SERVICE (WITHOUT NOTICE)




1. The without notice originating application made by **WILLIAM GUY BLACK** and **CONOR JOHN MCELHINNEY** on the day of September 2017 was determined by the Honourable Justice *Venning* on the *7th* day of September 2017.
2. The determination was made without a hearing.
3. The following orders were made:
 - (a) the applicants are granted leave to commence this originating application without notice;
 - (b) under s 255(4) of the Companies Act 1993 ("**Act**"), the requirements under s 255(2)(c)(ii) and (d) of the Act relating to the service of the liquidator's first report, notice and list of creditors, and the liquidators' subsequent six-monthly reports, and, under s 257(2) of the Act, the requirements under s 257(1)(a) of the Act relating to service of the liquidators' final report (together, "**Liquidators' Reports**"), be modified and instead permitting the applicants to provide notice of the Liquidators' Reports to Shareholders of IEG:
 - (i) by uploading the Liquidators' Reports to the applicants' website page concerning the liquidation of IEG at www.mcgrathnicol.co.nz;
 - (ii) to the Registrar of Companies for registration in the usual way; and
 - (iii) notifying shareholders of the abovementioned methods of service by posting an announcement on the New Zealand Stock Exchange ("**NZX**") stating that all Liquidators' Reports will be available from McGrathNicol's website and from the Companies Office website.
 - (c) within 5 working days of any orders being granted, notice of any orders to be given to shareholders of IEG by:
 - (i) posting notice on the applicants' website page concerning the liquidation of IEG; and



- (ii) posting an announcement on the NZX;
- (d) leave is granted to any shareholder to apply within 15 working days of the steps taken in paragraph 3(c) above, to modify or discharge these orders on appropriate notice being given to the applicants; and
- (e) leave is reserved for the applicants to apply further in respect of any ancillary orders arising out of the orders made.
