**ORDER OF MASTER SANDERSON
MADE 28 October 2021**

UPON THE APPLICATION of the plaintiffs by originating process filed 23 April 2021 AND UPON HEARING Ms J K Taylor SC and Mr P Edgar for the plaintiffs, Mr S J Maiden QC via video link and Mr J G Abberton for the first and third interested parties and Dr R Higgins SC and Mr J Hutton via video link for the second interested party, AND for reasons published 20 October 2021, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Pursuant to section 444GA(1)(b) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) (Corporations Act) that the plaintiffs jointly and severally have leave to transfer all of the existing shares (Shares) in the capital of Tiger Resources Limited (Subject to Deed of Company Arrangement) (Company) from the members (as defined in the Corporations Act) of the Company (Members) to Yingkou Yangzhou Trade Co Ltd (YYTCL) or its nominee on the Effectuation Date as defined in the deed of company arrangement dated 19 February 2021 (DOCA) and in accordance with its terms.
2. Pursuant to section 447A(1) of the Corporations Act and section 90-15(1) of the Insolvency Practice Schedule (Corporations) at Schedule 2 to the Corporations Act, any of the plaintiffs may, jointly or severally, in their capacity as Deed Administrators of the Company:
 - (a) execute on behalf of the Members share transfer forms and any other documents ancillary or incidental to effecting the transfer of the Shares referred to in Order 1; and
 - (b) enter or procure the entry of the name of YYTCL or its nominee into the share register of the Company in respect of all Shares transferred to YYTCL or its nominee in accordance with Order 1.

3. On or before 3 November 2021, each of the plaintiffs and the first, second and third interested parties file and serve any outline of submissions as to the costs of the originating process filed 23 April 2021.
